

## **Medicaid Redetermination**

Medicaid redetermination is the process where Medicaid members report their income to the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services every 12 months to determine if they can maintain their Medicaid eligibility. This process was paused during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.

Michigan has restarted Medicaid eligibility renewals for enrollees in Medicaid, MI Health Link, Healthy Michigan Plan, MIChild, and Dual Special Needs (D-SNP) plans. Recently, MDHHS began mailing a renewal packet to Medicaid members with June renewal dates. Mailings will continue monthly based on the anniversary of the beneficiary eligibility determination.

## **Application review**

MDHHS will review the application and notify the member of an approval or denial. Medicaid members will continue to be eligible for and receive Medicaid benefits until the last day of their renewal month or approved to maintain their eligibility. MDHHS will contact disenrolled members who don't meet the federal poverty level to see if they qualify for a Federally Qualified Exchange product.

## **HAP Empowered is here to help!**

We also shared information with providers and asked them to remind their Medicaid patients about redetermination.
