## Molina is Contracting for Doula Services Now Covered by Medicaid

As of January 1, 2023, Medicaid now covers prenatal, labor, birth and/or postpartum doula services for Medicaid and MMP members. For the benefit, doulas must be registered with the MDHHS Doula Registry and registered in CHAMPS. No prior authorization is required for the benefit. ## What is a doula?

A doula is a non-clinical person who typically provides physical, emotional, and educational support services to pregnant individuals during the prenatal, labor and delivery, and postpartum periods.
