



## **Notice from LARA – Upcoming Electronic-Prescribing Enforcement Coming January 1, 2023**

On October 3, 2022, the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) sent a formal statement to prescribers confirming that the Bureau of Professional Licensing (BPL) expects to begin enforcement of Michigan's electronic prescribing standard on January 1, 2023. Per the notice, BPL's enforcement of the electronic prescribing standard will coincide with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' (CMS) enforcement schedule for Part D prescription drug programs.

Michigan's statute allows for a waiver to be issued if a prescriber cannot meet the electronic prescribing requirements. The form and instructions for applying for the waiver is posted on the [BPL website](#).
